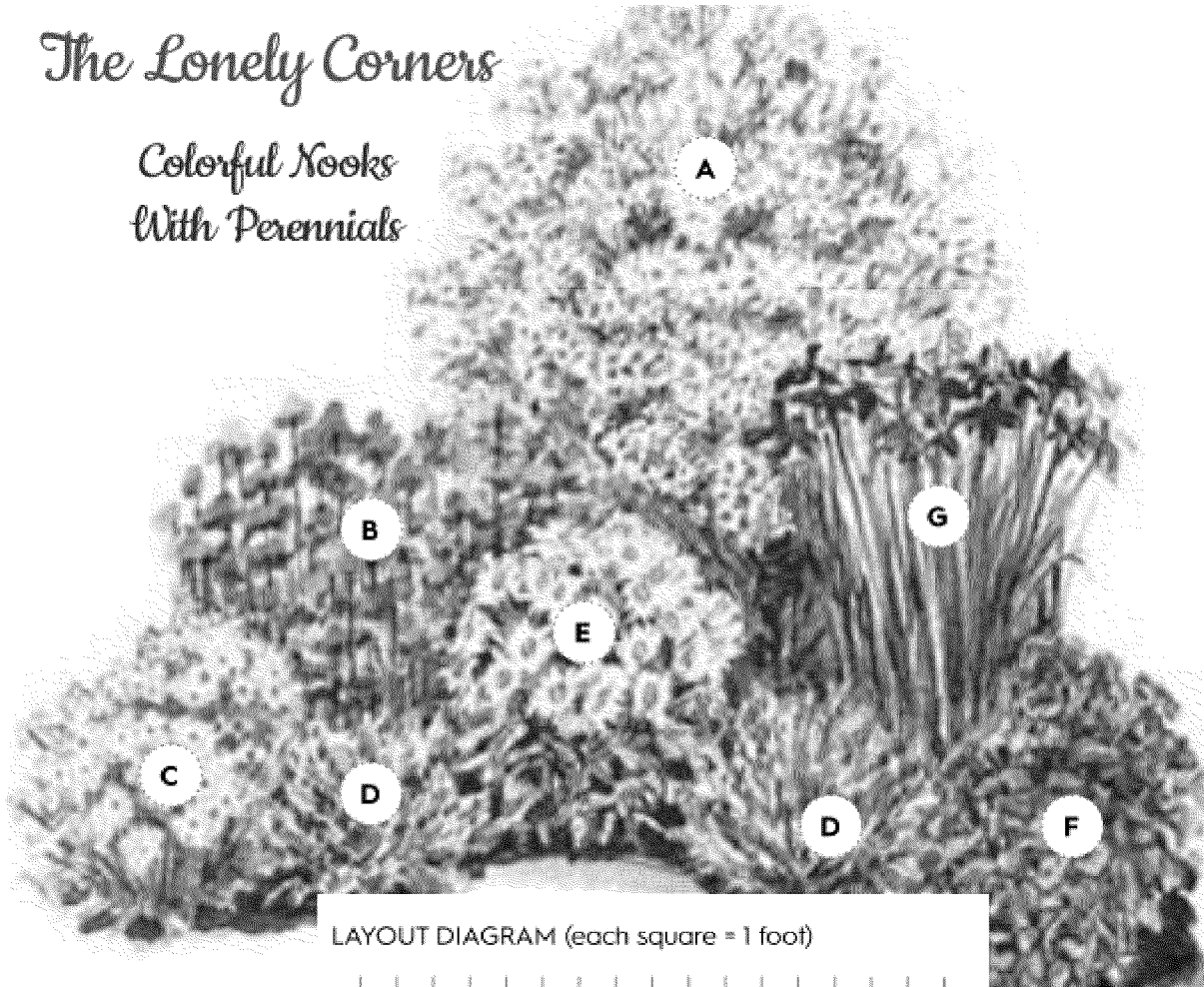
We all have them.....

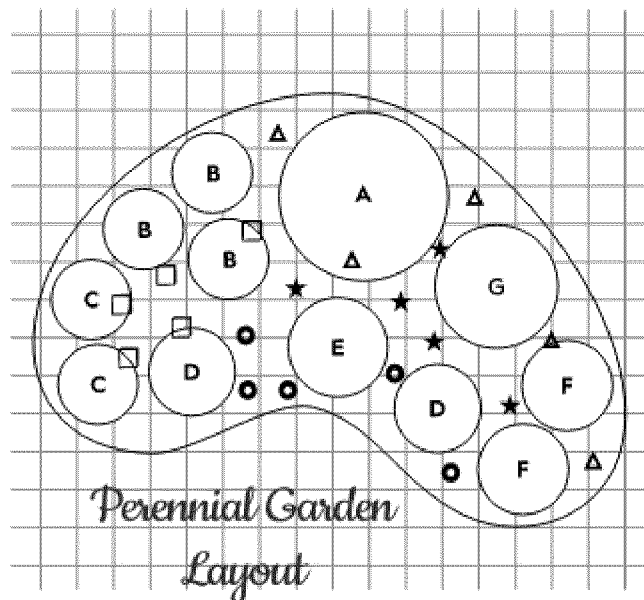

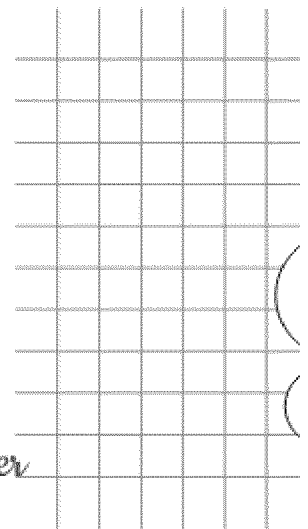
